

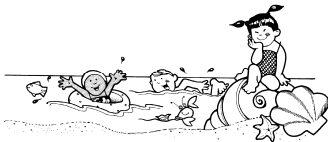
TRINITY WEEKDAY SCHOOL

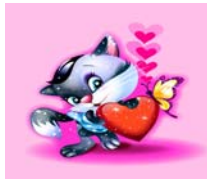

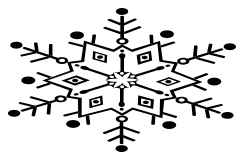
Remember our teachers and Mrs Luckhardt are always ready to talk with you. Just let us know, and we will schedule a special time.

We ended the month of January by beginning a unit on Good Health. We will begin February by talking about Valentine's Day. Of course we will be getting ready for our Valentine's Day Party.

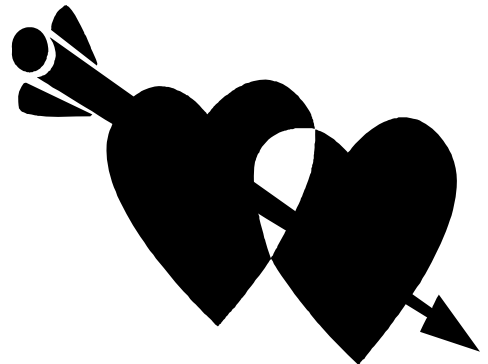
After Valentine's Day we will begin a unit on Oceans. The children will be learning lots of facts about the ocean and all the different kinds of things that live in the ocean.

Pre-K students continue to work with numbers, letters and patterning skills.

3's are practicing small motor skills and working with shapes and numbers. They have begun to use scissors. Practicing this skill at home will help them improve their skills.

As always, we spend lots of time working with all the children to develop listening skills, good social skills and directional skills, as well as overall responsibility skills. We are getting lots of positive feedback from the kindergarten teachers telling us that the children are very well prepared for kindergarten. For those of you who have children entering kindergarten, you should be looking for registration information. It will be coming up soon.
