UNITS OF STUDY

The month of April will begin with a Christian Unit. After that we will be learning about the Farm. Luke 24:34.* We will also continue to work toward accomplishing our academic objectives for the year. We recently met with the kindergarten teachers from Bower Hill and Pleasant Valley Elementary Schools. They mentioned how much they appreciate the work we do with readiness skills. You may not realize how much time we spend developing these skills with the children. We work on listening skills, taking turns, and raising hands to answer questions. We also teach the children to be responsible for their belongings. They learn to get their own papers and put them in their backpacks. We also work on following multiple directions, and working independently. These are just a few of the skills we build into our program every day. We are also incorporating some of the character building curriculum that has been emphasized in the elementary schools. Of course we are constantly working on developing small motor skills as well continuing to develop knowledge and recognition of letters and numbers. If we can lay this ground work for kindergarten, it makes it easier for the teachers to get started right away with academics in the beginning of the year.



MAY LUNCHEON

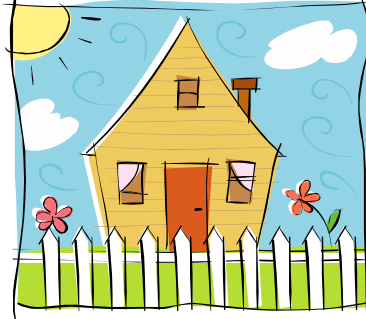
